

EARLY TERMINATION FROM SUPERVISION

Pursuant to the Federal Criminal Code and Rules, 18 U.S.C. 3564(c) and 3583(e)(1), an early termination of a term of probation or supervised release may be considered at any time in the case of a misdemeanor or at any time after the expiration of one year of probation or supervised release.

The LISC officers regularly review cases for early termination eligibility. Should your case be determined appropriate for an early termination, you will be notified directly by your LISC officer.
